

Council Report 12/16/19

The 12/12/19 church council meeting was cancelled and the team met informally Sunday 12/15/19 before services. Sue, Jared, and Lori were present.

The issue with PayPal has been resolved and the funds deposited to the church's general funds.

A meeting with our insurance representative revealed that we are most likely over-insured for the size of the church building and could also save annually by increasing our deductible. Workers compensation coverage was strongly recommended, even though paid workers are technically independent contractors. The cost of that coverage would be offset by savings on property and deductible. She will discuss these as well as the cost of covering the parsonage property with her underwriting department and get back to us. Liability coverage on the parsonage would not be changed and no changes will be made while the Hartfelders continue to use the property.

This info, when received, will be worked into next year's budget and will subsequently be reported to the congregation for approval.
